Update on STH 55 and Ludwig Street Sanitary Sewer Relay – Contract B-21 – Project is complete there has been no final pay request submitted yet.

Update on Bell Court & Elk Lane sewer relay project – Contract A-22. No change order or pay application. Rework has been completed and televised. All looks good.

Update was given on Country Fields Subdivision water and sewer install. The Schmidt Rd portion has been pressure tested.

Discuss future extensions of Parkway Lane. This was discussed at the Town level. The Town gave permission to Cedar and Frassetto to move forward with right-a-way acquisition and creation of potential TID. Frassetto will be negotiating with property owner(s).

Engineers Report – Dean discussed the status of Cedar Corporation working for the Town. The Town has been bringing in other engineers to discuss work with them and reaching out to other engineering firms but has not updated Cedar on their status with the Town.
