

**ORDINANCE 23-04**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 14 – LAW ENFORCEMENT - OF THE TOWN OF FREEDOM  
MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**WHEREAS** the Town of Freedom passed resolution 19-07, a resolution approving an agreement with Outagamie County for enhanced county law enforcement services in the Town of Freedom pursuant to §59.03(2)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes on August 28, 2019; and

**WHEREAS** resolution 19-07 states “pursuant to §62.13(2s)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes the Town Police Department shall be abolished as of 11:59 p.m. on August 31, 2019, which as a matter of law, shall result in the elimination of all positions within the Town Police Department as of the same date and time”; and


**WHEREAS** resolution 19-07 further states “that pursuant to §62.13(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town repeals the ordinance that established the Board of Police commissioners for the Town Police Department, effective as of 11:59 p.m. on August 31, 2019”; and

**WHEREAS** an ordinance may only be repealed by ordinance; and

**WHEREAS** there is no record of an ordinance passed that repeals Chapter 14 of the Town of Freedom Municipal Code of Ordinances.

**NOW THEREFORE** be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Freedom that Chapter 14 of the Town of Freedom Municipal Code of Ordinances is repealed in its entirety.
