October 12, 2018

Meeting called to order at 6:30 a.m. at the Freedom Sanitary District Office

Verification of posting as indicated on the bottom of the agenda.

Motion by Chris Evers to adopt the agenda. Second by Eugene Klister. Motion Carried (3-0).

Discussion was held regarding BelGioioso potentially building a Wastewater Treatment Facility within the Sanitary District boundary that will not discharge to the Sanitary District collection system. VanLieshout explained that our current ordinance does not allow for a Wastewater Treatment Facility to discharge outside of the District. It does allow for pretreatment with it being discharged to the District collection system. The District would need to amend the ordinance in order for it comply.


Frassetto stated that he did not feel the ordinance specifically addresses industrial strength not being discharged into the District collection system.

There was much discussion on the subject. The District reiterated that we are not looking to make development harder, but we need to be looking out for the District and its users. There was a large pipe installed on CTH S with the intention to service BelGioioso more than what we do. The lift station was also upgraded to take care of more flow. Currently we have to clean the pipe more often because we do not have enough flow. The District commissioners asked questions of the Town regarding where in the discharge permit process BelGioioso was and if they had specifics on what they were proposing. The Town was unable to provide any of the information. Steve Frassetto mentioned that he understands that the District does not want to make a decision without the right information. He and Steve Brueggeman would work on gathering that information and get it back to us.

We will discuss more when the additional information is received.
