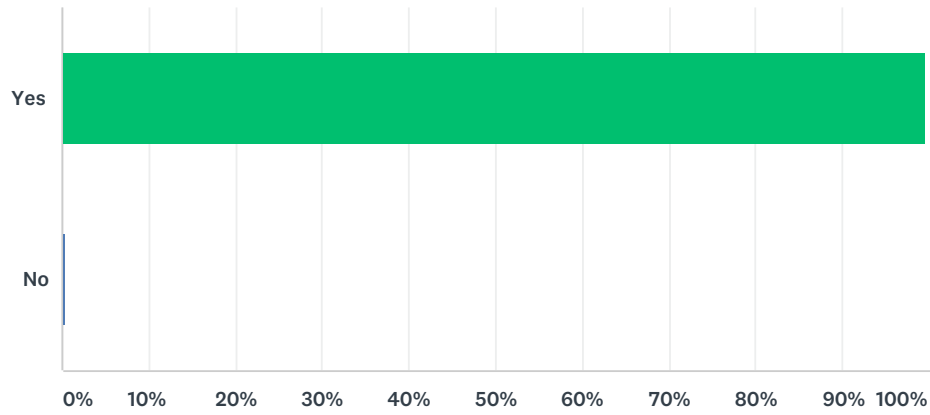

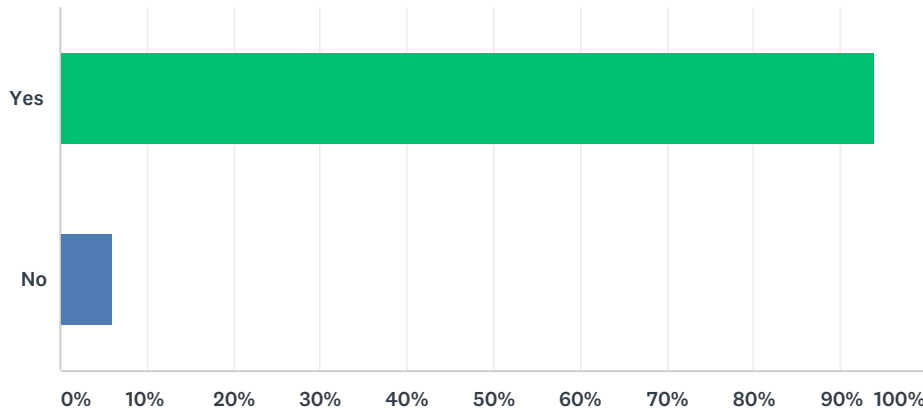

Q2 Do you own property in the Town of Freedom?

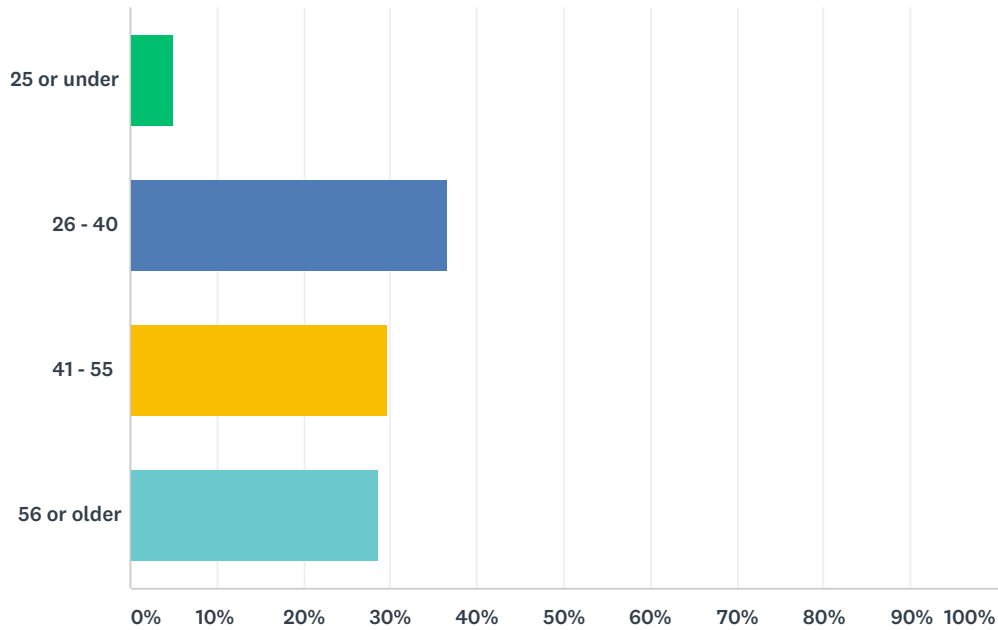

Q3 Your Age Range?

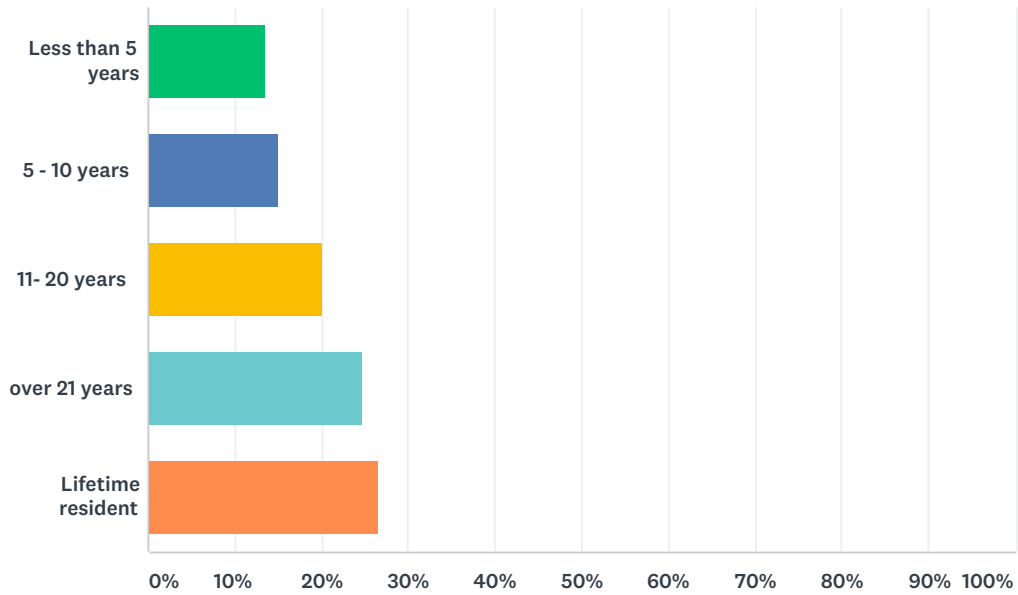

Q4 How long have you lived in the Town of Freedom?

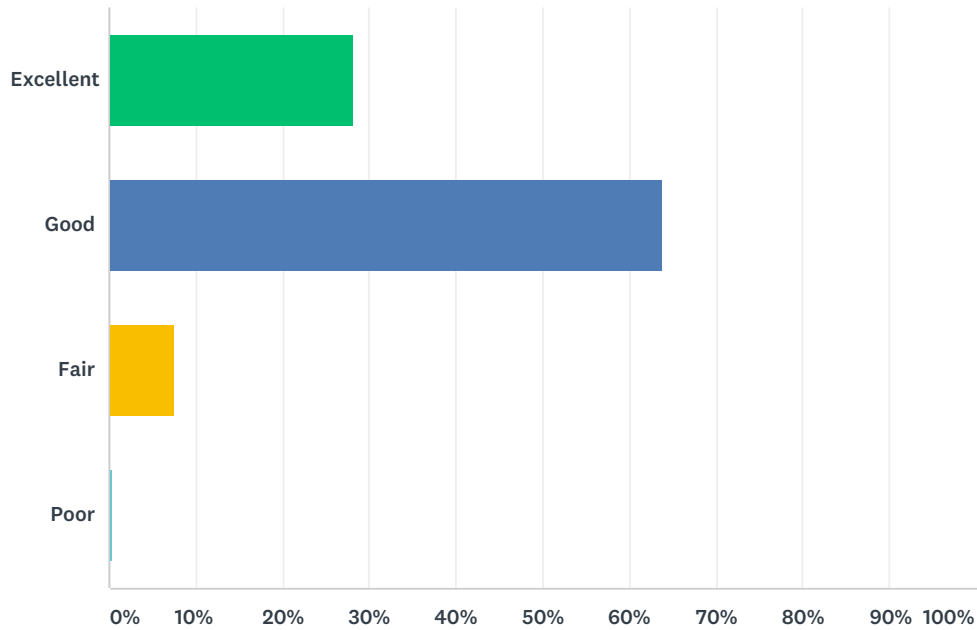

Q5 How would you rate the quality of life in the Town of Freedom?

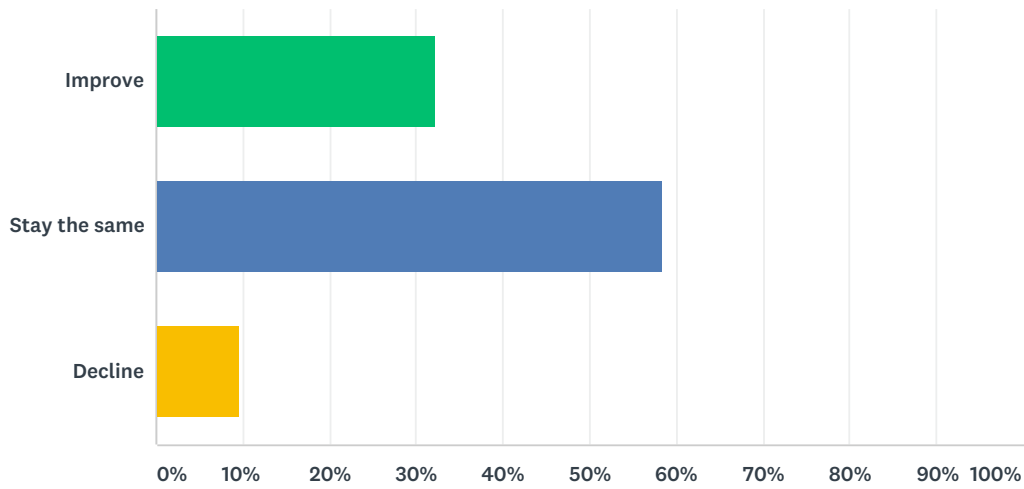

Q6 During the next five years, do you expect the quality of life in the Town of Freedom to:

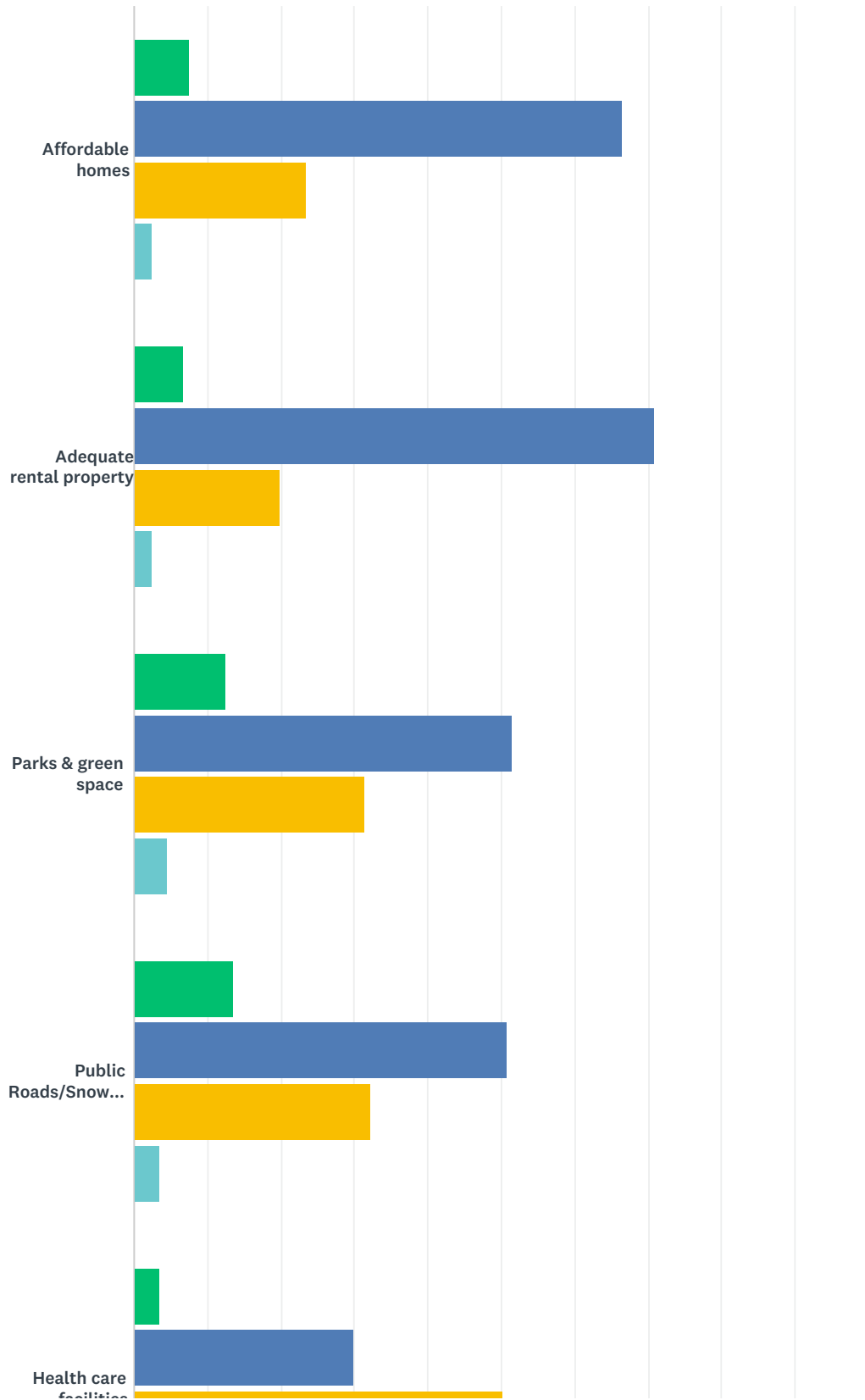

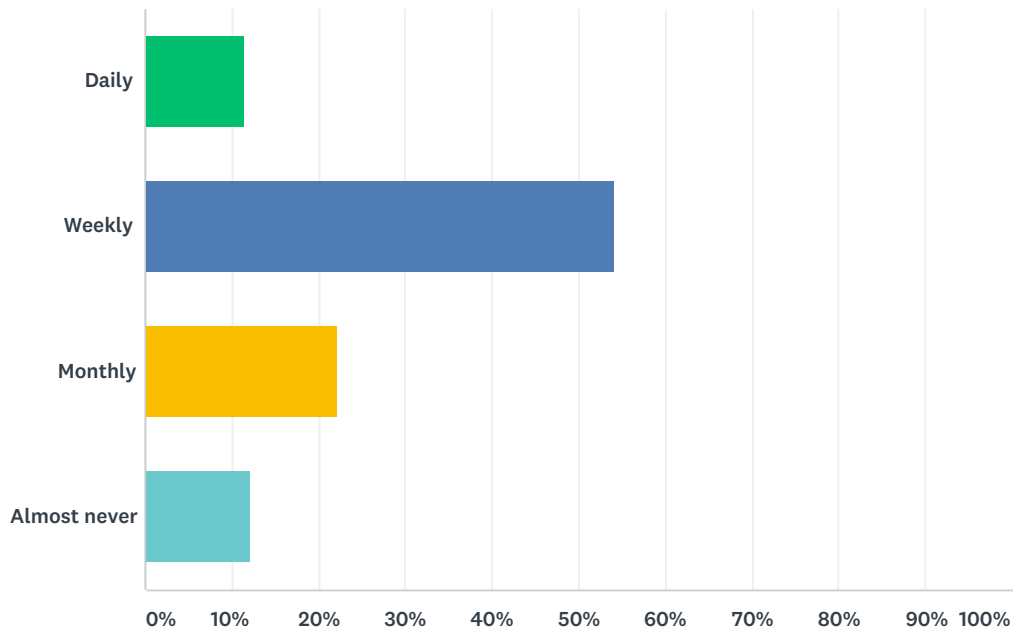

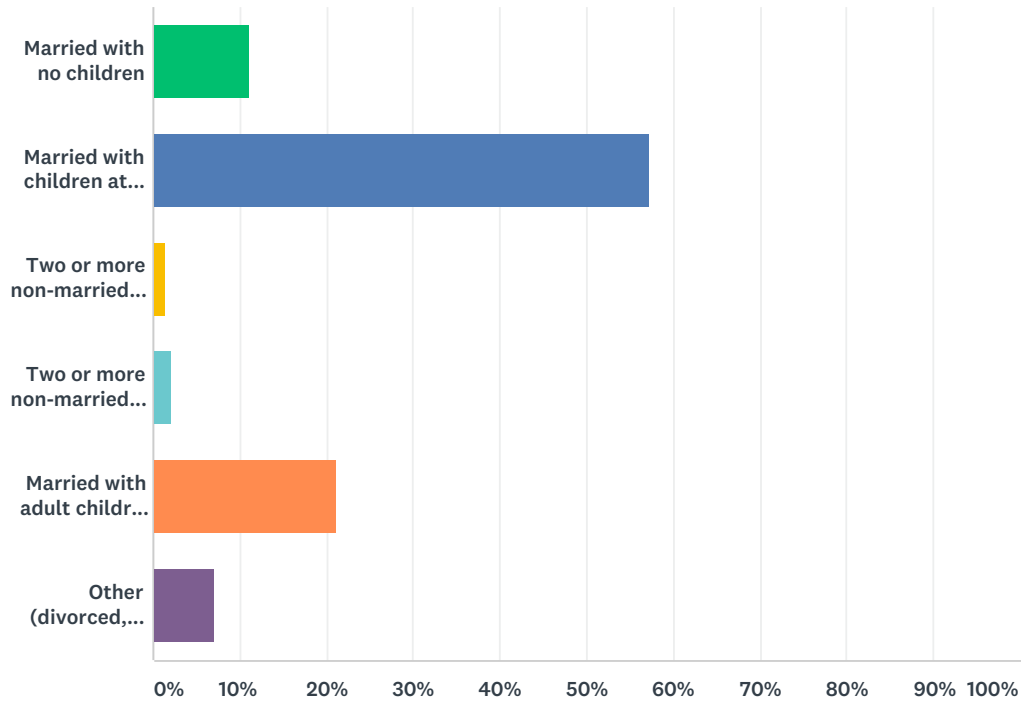

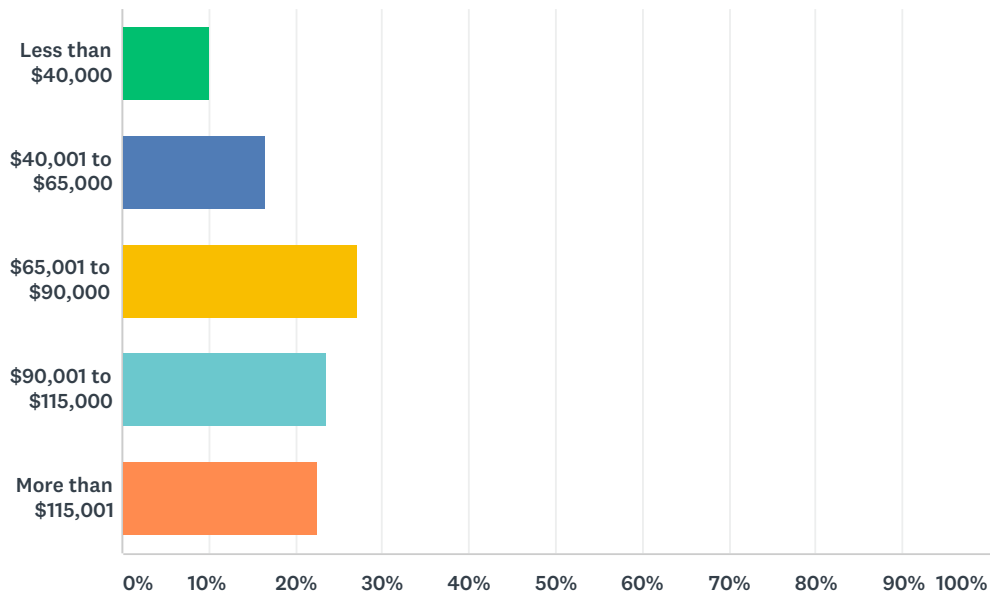

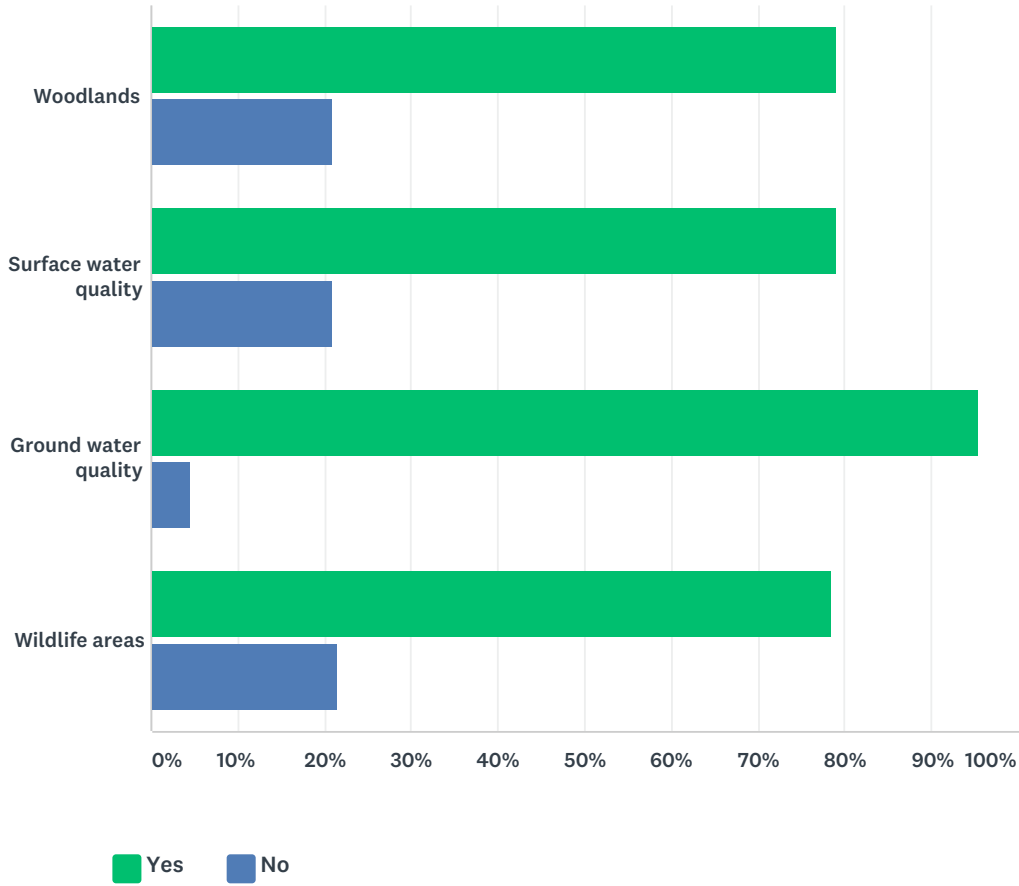

Q29 Identify which environmental issues you feel are important:

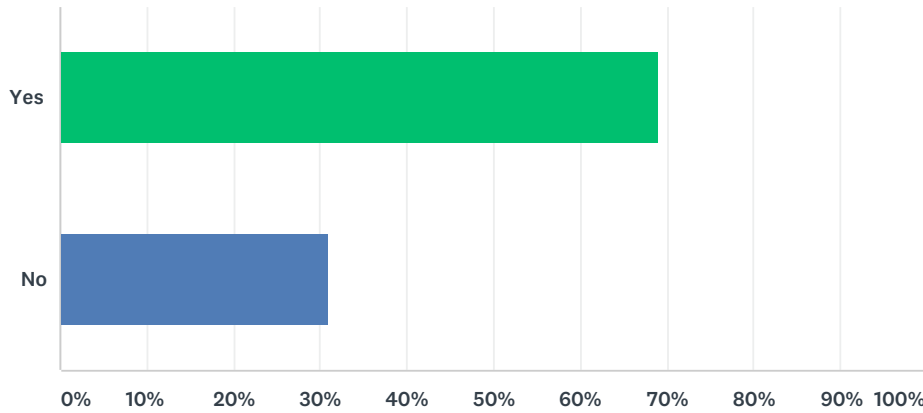

Q30 Do you feel the Township should develop ordinances for the protection of natural resources?

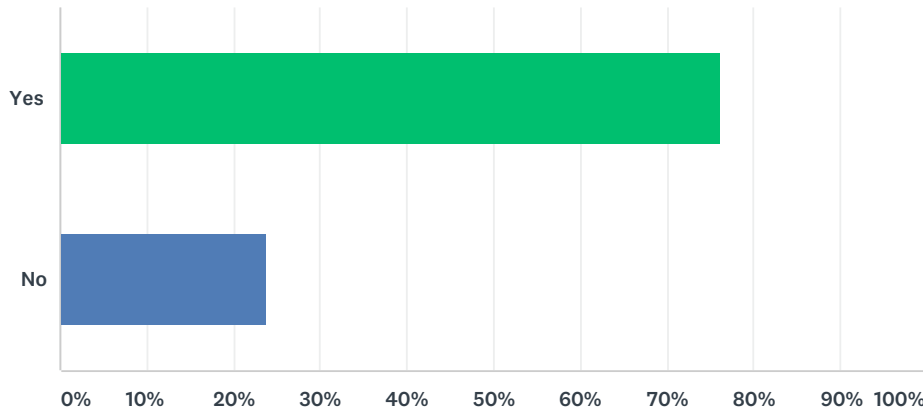

Q31 Would you support the development of Conservation Developments?

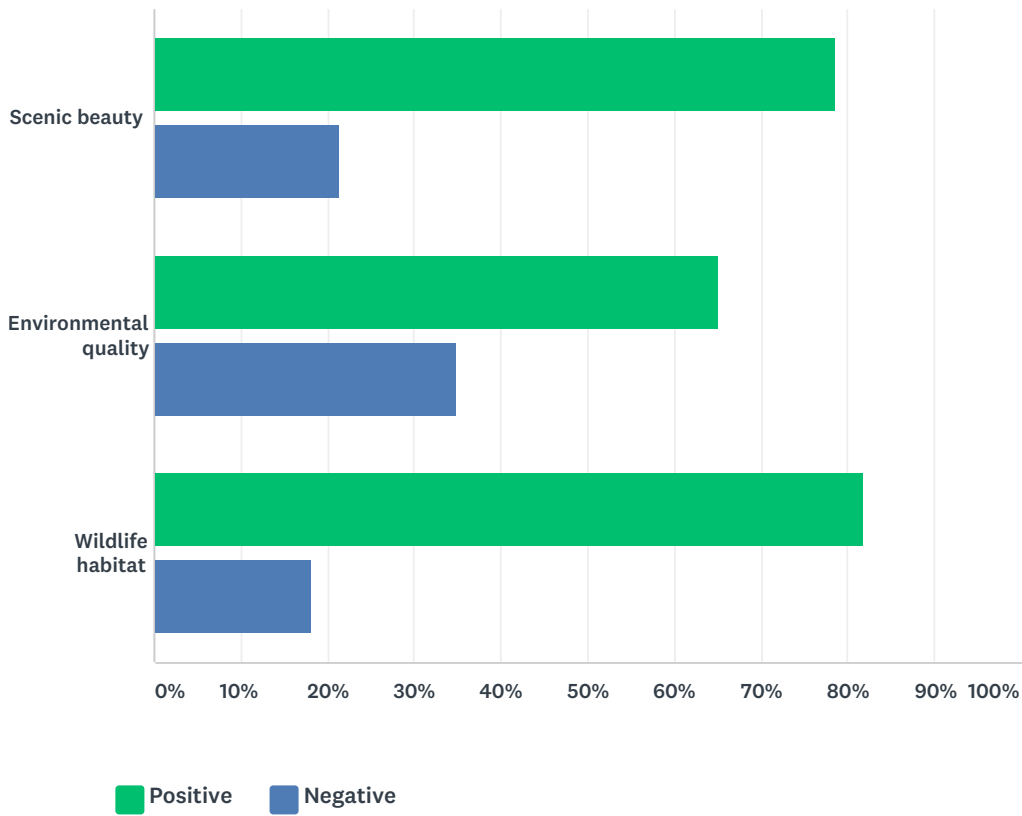
