MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Freedom, Outagamie County

The Town of Freedom, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, by this proclamation, adopted by Town Board Chairperson Charles Kramer, pursuant to his emergency powers under Wis. Stat. sec. 60.24(1)(e)(1-3) and 323.15, resolves and orders as follows:

An emergency is declared as existing within the Town of Freedom, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, for the following reasons: Imminent COVID-19 pandemic.

The period of the emergency shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist in the Town of Freedom.

The Town Board or their designated agents, have the authority to order whatever is legally permitted and necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare and good order of the Town of Freedom during the emergency, including without limitation the power to bar, restrict, and remove all unnecessary traffic, vehicular or pedestrian, from the local highways.

Any person who violates a lawful order of the town board or its agents made under this emergency declaration shall forfeit no more than \$100 or in default or payment of the forfeiture, shall be subject to imprisonment for six months for each separate offense.

The Town Clerk shall post this proclamation, at the Town Hall and on the Town website. This proclamation shall become effective immediately upon posting.
