Update on repainting of tower project was given. Cedar will be working on finalizing plans for water tower painting so that it can get bid out now. We have not heard received any correspondence from the WI DNR yet. Terri and Dean met with AT&T contractors for temporary antennas and discussing the project. Further discussions will need to happen with them.

Update on Hwy 55 sewer replacement and DOT project was given. The area for construction was reviewed. We will be putting it out for bid this spring, looking at opening bids end of March/beginning of April. We will allow the project to be completed in fall.

Update on potential developments. Small development group met with developer on Monday. Discussion was had regarding the potential development area in TID #1. Developer was going to do some research and meet again in mid-February.

- The DNR has done the public notice for the update to our permit for our thermal limits. With the reports completed by Cedar and the data provided by staff we were able to have a thermal limit removed from our permit. If we had not taken those steps, the District would need to find alternate ways to obtain dissipative cooling.
