TOWN OF FREEDOM SPECIAL NOTICE

Regulations on Open Burning

- Burning Permits are required for piles of brush/garden/leaves/drywood, etc. that are large than 4' x 4' x 3' high and/or outside the approved burning hours.
- Burning shall be permitted only during the hours of 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. and must be attended at all times!
- Burning is not allowed if winds exceed 10 mph as measured by the National Weather Service or if other atmosphere conditions or circumstances make such fire hazardous.
- The Fire Chief, Police Chief or their designee can require that burning be discontinued if conditions are determined to constitute a hazard.
- Burning shall not be conducted within 50' of any building, structure, trees or brush or within 50' of any combustible material.
- Fuel for open burning shall consist of dry materials only and shall not be ignited with flammable or combustible liquids.
- Reasonable accommodations shall be provided for the control and extinguishments of fire.

NOTE: The burning of trash, garbage, paper or cardboard, plastic, treated or painted materials, furniture, shingles, construction or demolition debris, oil, oily wastes, asphalt or asphalt alike materials, rubber, or synthetic rubber like materials, paint or other combustible and flammable materials and household or business waste is prohibited by local ordinance and/or State Statute.
