#### **Department of Public Works Lead Worker Position**

The Town of Freedom is seeking applicants for a full-time Department of Public Works Lead worker position.

The successful applicant will perform the duties including maintenance of town roads, right-of-way, signs, buildings & grounds, snow removal & salting operations, brush pick-up, minor to major pavement repair, concrete flatwork, repair and cleaning of storm sewer catch basins, storm sewer maintenance and repairs, storm sewer and lateral locate marking as needed, vehicle & equipment maintenance, park maintenance, grass mowing, preparing diamonds and landscape related activities; general forestry, and general public works activities including assisting at the yard waste drop off site and parks maintenance as needed. Must be reliable and capable of repetitive lifting of up to 50 lbs. and occasional lifting of up to 75 lbs. Ability to work in confined spaces and in all weather conditions.

A minimum of one year of experience in public works or a related field and some experience operating trucks and construction equipment is preferred. Applicants must have a minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent and must possess a CLASS B CDL with air brakes or within 90 days of hire. Drug Test and background check required. Prior municipal laborer and snow plowing experience preferred. Must be available for afterhours emergencies, on evenings, weekends, and holidays. This is a full-time, non-exempt position with an hourly hiring range, \$25.00-\$30.00 per hour plus excellent benefits.
