You can register at the polls on April 2, 2024

OR

Registration in the office of the Town Clerk can be conducted up to 5:00 p.m. the Friday before an election or on election day (Please Note: Town Hall is closed on Fridays. In-office registration after office hours must be done by appointment only). Voter registration is not allowed the Monday before an election.

You will need your WI Driver's License (or Social Security # if you do not have a driver's license) and proof that you have lived at your present location for at least **28** days preceding the election.

NOTICE: At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of the WI Stat. 19.84, the Election Inspectors at this polling place will convene as the Local Canvassing Board for the purpose of conducting the local canvas pursuant to WI Stat 7.51. This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to WI Stats 19.89 – 90.

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before election day to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
