


Town of Freedom Residents

Trash (weekly) and Recycling (every-other week) pickup will continue to be on Tuesday and Wednesday

Residents will now be provided with (1) 95 gallon recycling tote, in addition to the (1) 95 gallon trash tote. All recycled items must be rinsed out and caps removed. Cardboard is to be broken down to a 2ft x 3ft in size maximum.

Garbage/recycling needs to be curbside no later than 5:00 am on scheduled pickup day to guarantee pickup.

- Please place trash and recycling tote as indicated in the picture, with the bar and lid opening street side. Recycling needs to be placed NEXT to the trash tote on the same side of the driveway for collection. The collection system will require that the provided cart is mechanically picked up and then tipped into the truck. Residents are required to use provided carts for their household garbage and household recycling.
- Each household is allowed (1) tote of recycling every other week.
- Place your cart(s) to maintain a (3) foot separation from obstructions, including other carts, mailboxes, parked cars, trees and snow banks
- These totes are the property of Harter's, for tote repair or rental of additional totes; please call (715) 253-2619 or (888)804-8556. In the event you relocate, these carts are to stay with the property.

- **Holiday Collection.** Extra Bags may be placed outside the container only on the next collection day following a holiday.

<p><u>Do Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aluminum cans & bottles • Steel & bi-metal cans • Metal lids & caps • Empty aerosol cans NOT containing a pesticide <p><u>Don't Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pots & Pans • Sheet metal • Aluminum pans & foil • Car parts • Small appliances • Nails & screws <p><u>Guidelines:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse cans & bottles • No need to remove labels • Remove plastic caps & nozzles from aerosol cans 	<p><u>Do Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic bottles & jugs (#1 PETE), such as water & soda bottles • Plastic bottles & jugs (#2 HDPE), such as milk jugs & laundry bottles <p><u>Don't Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #1 clam shell containers • #2 Tubs • #3-#7 Bottles/containers • Plastic bags • Motor oil bottles, brake & transmission fluid bottles • Styrofoam • Pails (ice cream & kitty litter) • Flower pots • Food storage & microwave containers <p><u>Guidelines:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse bottles & jugs • No need to remove labels • Remove all caps & lids 	<p><u>Do Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrugated cardboard • Newspaper & inserts • Junk mail, Phone books, catalogs & magazines • Books • Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes, frozen food boxes) • Office & writing paper • Brown paper bags • Shredded paper (place in a brown paper bag & staple) <p><u>Don't Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tissue products & diapers • Paper contaminated with food or grease (pizza box) • Gift wrap or Waxed paper <p><u>Guidelines:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove plastic liners from paperboard boxes • Flatten & cut cardboard to no larger than 3' x 3' 	<p><u>Do Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Soda, beer & juice bottles • Foods jars (pickles, salsa, jelly, etc) • Glass food containers, any color <p><u>Don't Recycle:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drinking glasses, crystal • Ceramic cups & plates • Dishes • China • Window glass • Plate glass, windshields • Light bulbs • Ovenware <p><u>Guidelines:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse bottles & jars • No need to remove labels • Metal caps & lids may be recycled • Discard plastic caps
