

**INFORMATIONAL MEETING
MARCH 30, 2016
6:00 P.M.
TOWN HALL
W2004 COUNTY RD S**

Informational meeting for residents adjacent to French Rd proposed construction area. There was a quorum of Town Board members that attended this meeting (as noticed) – Supv. Maass, Supv. Schuh and Supv. Rickert. There were no town presentations or decisions made by Town Board members at this meeting.

Engineer, Planner and Public Works Director Steve Brueggeman addressed the residents in attendance and explained that the town planned to pulverize and pave French Rd from E Broadway to just south of Evergreen Rd. – approx. 3500'. He noted that the pavement was distressed, had potholes and has a Paser 2 rating. Records show that 500 to 600 cars per day use the road. There is pedestrian and school traffic on this road. The lack of ditches (just slopes), 1 – 2' shoulders and undersize culverts are causing drainage and safety issues. Pulverize and pave would be done on 3100' creating 22' wide pavement, 3' shoulders and ditches would be reconstructed. The town is proposing that the north 400' (south of Evergreen) would be urban design with curb and gutter creating a roadway of 37'. A storm sewer drain would be created just north of the school and through a private property easement. Trees on the road within the 66' ROW would be removed. Temporary limited easements would be needed to properly slope the ditches. Project is scheduled from end of May through August 1. Road would be closed to through traffic. Road reconstruction would be 100% town cost. Church would have an assessment if they decide to go with the curb & gutter.

Bids for the project will be opened on April 26 for Town Board consideration on April 27.

Residents did voice concerns about speeding on French Rd. and the number of large trucks.

There was no opposition to the plan voiced at this meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
