

- a. The flicker or glint will not exceed 90 seconds per day with a 10 hour maximum per year.
 - b. The traffic volumes are less than 500 vehicles per day on a roadway where visual impacts may occur.
 - c. The flicker or glint does not fall onto an intersection.
2. Shadow flicker or blade glint expected to fall on a portion of a residence or business property may be acceptable if the flicker or glint will not exceed 90 seconds per day with a 10 hour maximum per year.
 3. Any complaint of such visual impacts shall be dealt with in accordance with the Reporting and Complaint Resolution procedures herein.

J. Setbacks.

Wind Turbines shall comply with the following minimum setbacks, which may be increased on a case-by-case basis by the Town Board in order to protect public health and safety:

1. ~~Setbacks. Each Wind Turbine must be set back:~~
 - a. ~~for a Large WES must be set back,~~ at least 1,150 feet from any residential, business, or public institutional building, unless the owner of the building such entity agrees to grant an easement to allow a reduced setback, which shall never be less than 1.1 times the total height of a Wind Turbine, from any non-participating property line.
 - b. ~~for a Small WES must be set back,~~ at least 1.1 times the total height of the wind turbine from any Non-Participating Property line. Notwithstanding this lower setback, a Small WES still must comply with all noise restrictions in Sections V1 (G) Noise.
 - c. ~~for a Large and Small WES must be set back,~~ at least 1.1 times the total height of the Wind Turbine from the property line of any Non-Participating Property and from any public road, railroad right-of-way, power line right-of-way, above-ground public electric power line, or telephone line.

K. Signage and Fencing.

1. Licensee shall provide reasonable signage at the Facility, identifying the Premises as being part of the Facility and providing appropriate safety notices and warnings against trespassing. The no trespassing signs shall be posted around the entire premises at an appropriate distance for posting but no less than 2 conspicuous places for every 40 acres within the Facility. Signs should be sized at a minimum to meet the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 943.013(2).
2. No advertising material or signage other than warning, equipment information or indicia of ownership shall be allowed on the Wind Turbines. This prohibition shall include the attachment of any flag, decorative sign,
